Zeynep: What photos?

Zeynep : They used to watch puppet shows, meddah, orta oyunu, etc.”Orta oyunu” is a Turkish folk theatre. People performed it in the open air.

Zeynep : People did not use to have TVs or personal computers then, so they came together in coffee houses. You know most men go to coffee houses to chat and talk about the matters of the day. Women never used to go to coffee houses, but now, in big cities, they go to some coffee houses.

John : Traditions and lifestyles change. We used to live in a small village when I was a child and there didn't use to be a secondary school. So, we moved and now we live in a big city. Everything is different in a big city. Traffic for example.

Zeynep : My grandfather says there didn't use to be any traffic jam in the main streets of this city 50 years ago.

John : So, modern life brings both advantages and disadvantages.

Zeynep : I prefer modern life, but we should protect our traditions too.
