Reporter: And now, could you please tell us briefly how you started this sport and what happened afterwards?

Hamza Yerlikaya: Sure. When I was a child, my father was fond of wrestling. That certainly affected me very much, and I started wrestling in İstanbul at the age of 10. I used to train really hard. Of course, my trainers helped me a lot to improve my talents. The first international tournament which I took part in was the 1991 World Championship in Canada.
